### 1. Raffles Fiesta on 23 & 24 May

The school will be organising the Raffles Fiesta on 23 and 24 May. Timetable will be suspended on these two days for students to participate in a slew of exciting activities which consolidate learning in various subject disciplines in fun and engaging ways.

We aim to broaden students' learning, provide opportunities for students to explore new interests/ pursue their passions and build camaraderie through these activities.

## 2. Food Donation Drive @ RGPS from Monday,6 May to Wednesday, 15 May 2024

The RGPS prefectorial committee has come together to initiate a donation drive in collaboration with Ronald Macdonald House Charities to put together a "Happy Snack Pack" for young patients either receiving outpatient care or undergoing day chemotherapy treatment or other procedures.

A child undergoing outpatient chemotherapy may be required to fast before treatment. The snack pack becomes not just an energy booster but also a "carrot" that motivates these children as they look forward to receiving a "Happy Snack Pack" from the nurse after the completion of the treatment. P4 Prefects will also be setting up a table during the P4 recess to encourage pupils to write get well notes to the recipients of the "Happy Snack Pack".

We hope that through this activity, pupils will be able to show gratitude for their own good health, empathy and graciousness towards others, especially those who are not as healthy and well as they are.

Each snack pack consists of a juice or milk packet, individually wrapped cookies/biscuits and gummies with natural flavours.

Pupils can participate in this collaboration by donating any of the food items listed below:

# Ronald Macdonald House Charities Singapore Oncology Happy Snack Pack

- Individual 200ml juice packets of Marigold Apple Juice (no sugar added).
- Individual 125ml or 200ml Milo packet drink.
- Individual 200ml Ribena packet drink.
- Individually wrapped snack/oat bar from Carman's, Nature Valley, Uncle Toby's or Yogood (ingredients must not have nuts as some children may be allergic to nuts).
- Individually wrapped biscuits.
- Individually wrapped packets of gummies with natural flavours from The Natural Confectionery Co. (25% less sugar) or YumEarth (packs of 0.7g each).

Please note that expiry date of food items must be at least 6 months away from May 2024.

Pupils can deposit their food items at the table in front of the prefectorial board along the corridor leading to the canteen or at the canteen pick-up point. Items can dropped off **before morning assembly** from **Monday**, 6 **May to Wednesday**, 15 **May 2024**.

### 3. Give@RGPS

Give@RGPS is a school-based project which builds and cultivates character and citizenry by providing opportunities for students' self-leadership, initiative, and involvement in school improvement.

A group of students from class 6D, Kaytlyn Cassidy, Charlize Chong, Natasha Sze Ying, and Natasha Teo Rui Qi, have initiated a project entitled, Give, Take, and Donate, to collect reusable items that can be passed on to others. They believe that by so doing, we are not only reducing waste but also giving others a chance to benefit from them. They hope that their project will inspire their school mates to be more mindful of their actions and their impact on our environment and community.

They will be setting up a booth at the canteen pick-up point from 8 to 10 May 2024 (Wednesday – Friday), from 7am to 7.25am to collect the re-usable items from their fellow schoolmates who wish to donate to them. If your child/ward has any suitable items that she would like to donate, please encourage her to do so during the above-mentioned dates. Please note that the items to be donated must be in good, usable conditions. The following items will not be accepted: food, personal items (eg. clothes, shoes, etc), bulky items, fragile items and story books.

The group will set up a booth at the canteen on 13 May 2024, at 1.25pm, to carry out the exchange of reusable items. Students may visit their booth on 13 May to pick any item from the booth that they can bring back to reuse. Students who are taking the school buses home on that day are reminded to be mindful of their time if they are visiting the booth; no extra time will be given to them to browse the items and they must board their school buses on time. Any remaining items will be donated to the Salvation Army.


