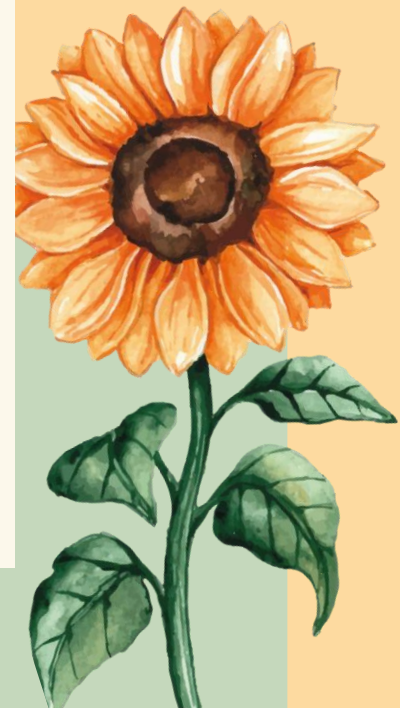

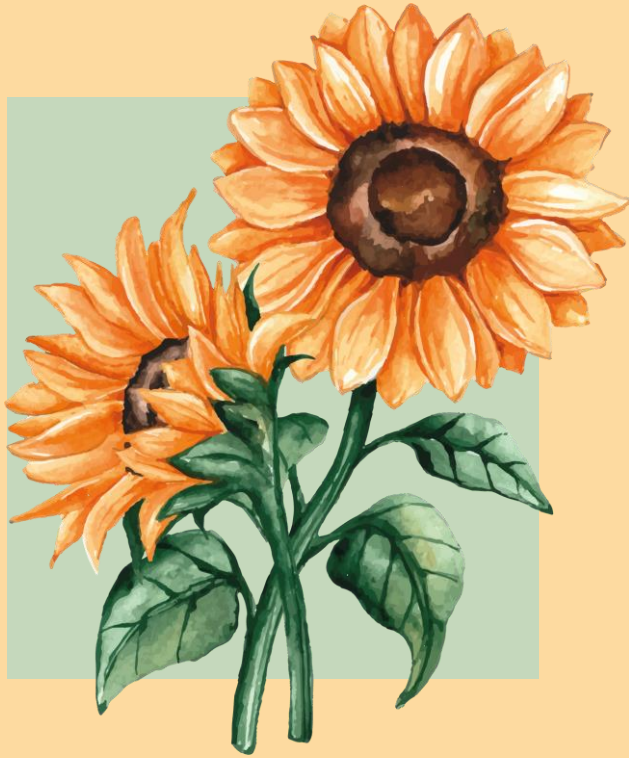

Home-School Agreement

We believe in home-school partnership in nurturing our girls to be *Women of Excellence, Leaders of Character and Service*. Thus, we would like to seek the cooperation of parents to ensure that our pupils learn effectively at school and become a person with good moral values. Your involvement and reinforcement at home in the following areas are important to us.

BEHAVIOUR

The School will:	Parents will :
Ensure every child is familiar with the school rules and practise them in school.	Help the child to understand and follow the school rules.
Reward and discipline the child fairly.	Encourage the child to learn from mistakes and not to repeat them and to reinforce good habits and behaviour. Understand that the school has a set of standards for the children to follow so that the school can cater for all even if it might cause certain inconvenience to some individuals.
Make sure that the school staff always sets a high and common standard of expected behaviour from the child.	Be familiar with the set of good behaviour accepted by the school and be role models for the child.

HOMEWORK and ASSIGNMENTS

The School will:	Parents will :
Set appropriate homework and assignments regularly to reinforce and deepen understanding of lessons taught.	Monitor the child so that the child completes her homework, assignments and corrections on her own and returns the homework to her teacher on time.
Set a good standard of assessments for the pupils to ensure that they have learnt and use the assessment information to move the learning forward.	Provide a conducive environment for the child to do their self-study and consistent revision.

Home-School Agreement

ATTENDANCE and PUNCTUALITY

The School will:	Parents will :
Start punctually unless the school gives notice in advance for a different time.	Make sure that the child is in school on time and is not absent without a valid reason.
Maintain an accurate record of attendance.	Hand the medical certificate or a letter of explanation for the child's absence to the form teacher promptly. Contact the school promptly when the child is absent from school or any other school activities. Refrain from taking the child out of school during curriculum time.
Ensure a safe and secure environment for the child to learn effectively.	Abide by the security measures put in place and all traffic rules within the school compound.

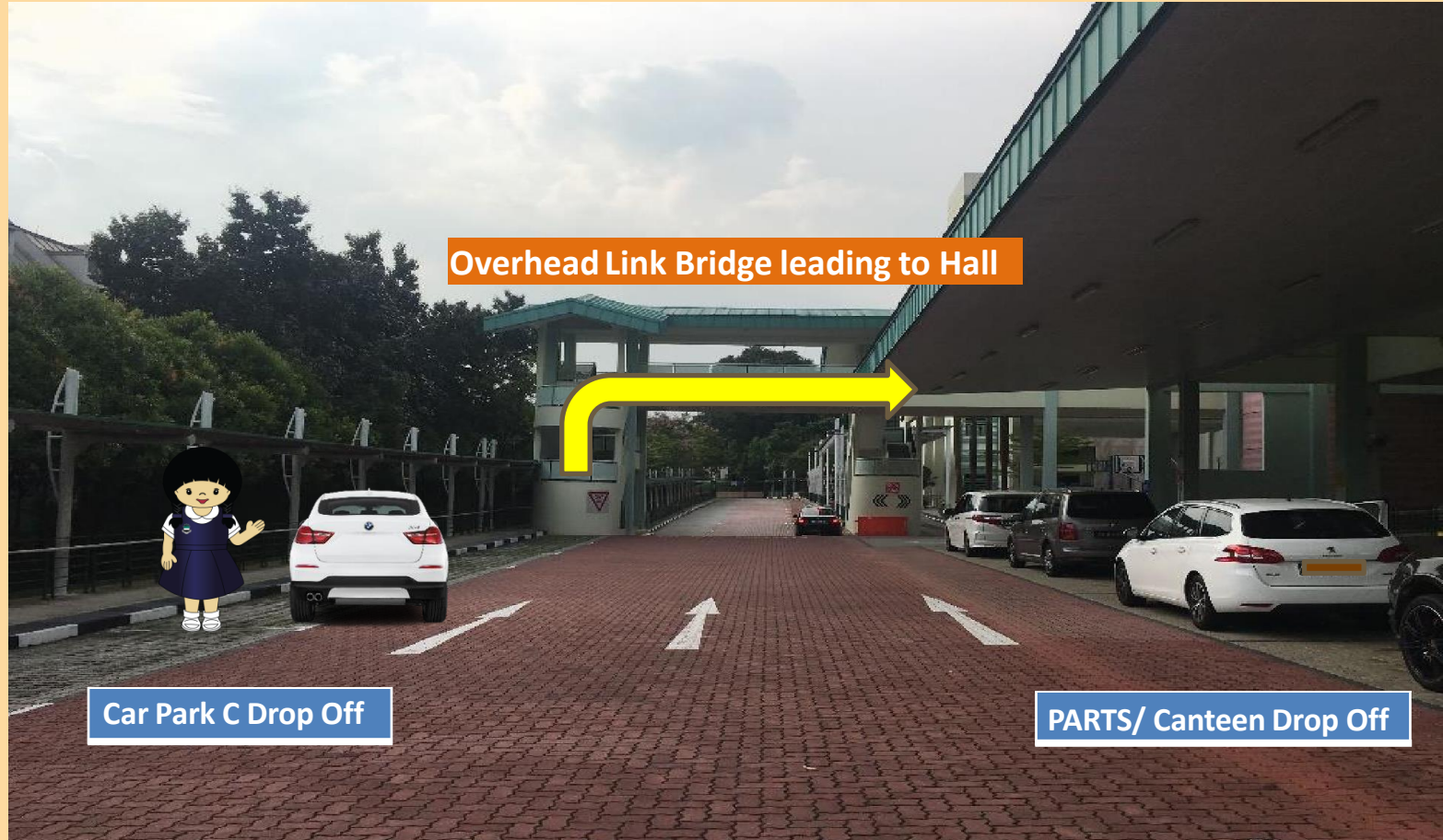

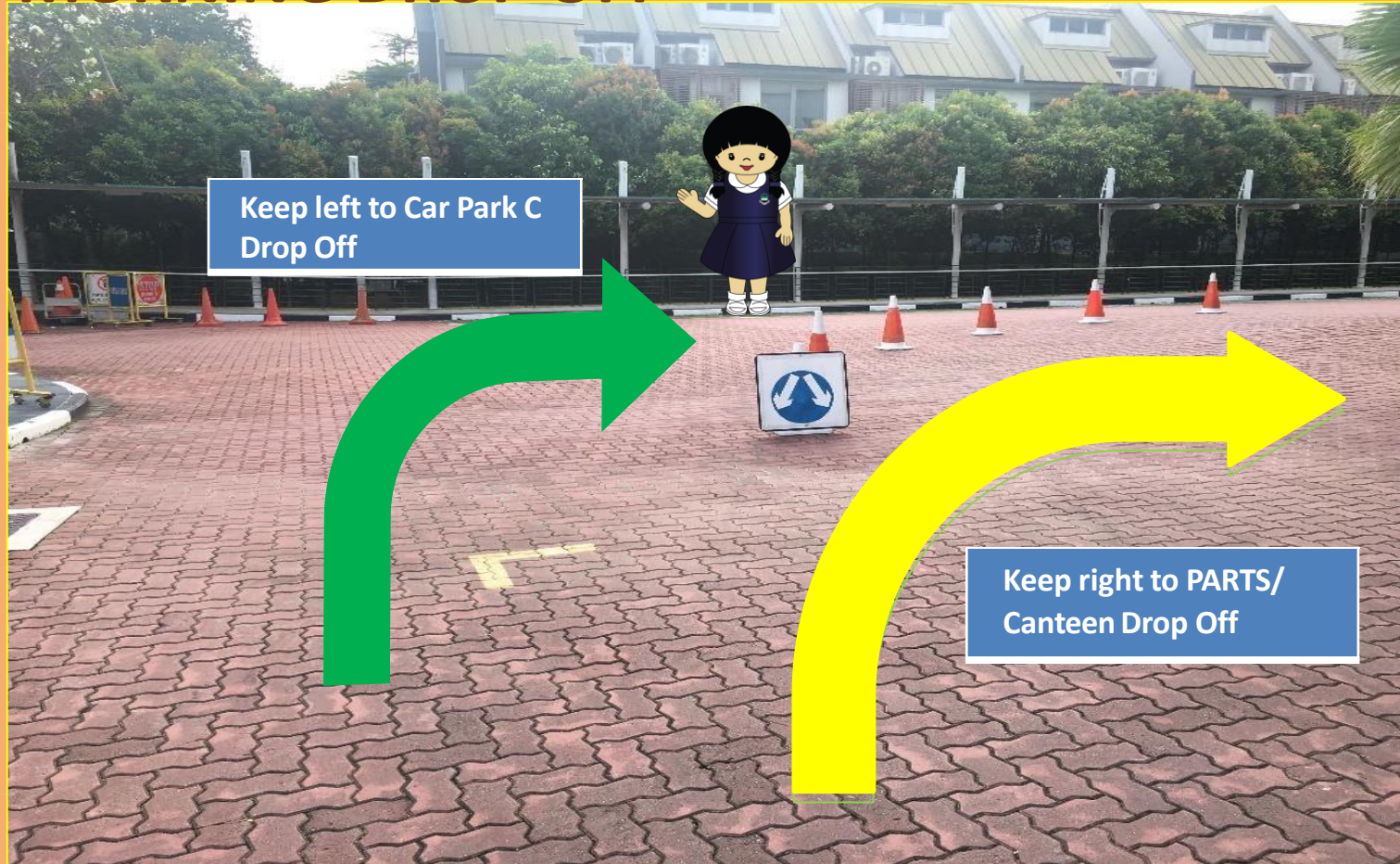


Overhead Link Bridge leading to Hall
