## **Registration for RGPS School-based Student Care Centre (SCC) for 2023 P1 Students**

Since 2017, the school has established a school-based Student Care Centre (SCC) in the school. The service provider for RGPS school-based SCC is KNOWLEDGE PARK EDUCARE (SC) PTE. LTD.

The RGPS school-based SCC will provide after-school care support for students whose parents are both working with no home support. You are invited to register your child/ward if you are keen. You can enroll your child/ward in the SCC to leverage on the learning and development support as well as supervision provided by the SCC. However, do note that the SCC does not provide tutoring services to the children.

Priority for admission to SCC will be given to students with higher needs. The enrolment of students in the SCC is a school-based decision. When demand for places is higher than the SCC can accommodate, the school will select students who will benefit most from SCC support. Reasons for selection/non-selection of students for the SCC will not be disclosed.

The SCC will operate on all school days apart from public holidays and weekends from 1.30p.m. to 7.00p.m. During the school holidays, the SCC will operate from 7.30a.m. to 7.00p.m. More details on the SCC can be found in the attached brochure.
