1. <u>Revised School Library Opening Hours</u>

With effect from Term 4 2023, the school library will close earlier on every Friday at 3.50 pm instead of 4.50 pm.

The revised opening hours of the school library will be as follow:

After the closure of the school library, students who are waiting to be picked up by their parents are to proceed to the canteen and wait there.

2. Home-Based Learning on 26 and 27 September 2023

The school will be implementing Home-Based Learning for our Primary 1 and Primary 2 students during the end-of-year oral examination for Primary 3 to Primary 5 students on 26 September and 27 September.

During the Home-Based Learning period, students are strongly encouraged to remain at home and complete the assigned work.

The Student Care Centre in school will remain open in the afternoons (1.30pm to 7pm). Students may report to lower canteen at 1.30pm for lunch.

3. Invitation for Video Submission of RGPS Got Talent for P1 (Term 4)

RGPS Got Talent is a platform for all students who wish to showcase their talents. Over the years, we have had many performances ranging from music to literal art forms. We are very encouraged by the enthusiastic response of our students in the participation of RGPS Got Talent. All interested students are welcome to submit recorded videos of their performances.

Please take note of the following:

- a. RGPS Got Talent is open to all P1 students this term.
- b. This event is not a competition. However, certificates of appreciation will be given to all selected applicants.
- c. Only shortlisted applicants will be notified.
- d. The performance can be solo, in pairs or maximum of 3 in a group.
- e. To give performing opportunities to a wider student base, we will not be selecting video submissions from the same applicant within the year. If students are interested to perform again, they can submit their applications in the following year.

Guidelines for RGPS Got Talent online video submission

- i. The performance video should not exceed 5 minutes.
- ii. Please ensure that the video resolution is good and <u>the student's face can be seen</u> <u>clearly</u>. There should be good lighting so that the student's face is well-lit in the video.

- iii. Please ensure that the audio/music is clear and audible. The environment should be quiet to minimise background noise.
- iv. For students who are singing a song, please use a minus-one music track (without vocals).
- v. For attire, students will wear the RGPS school uniform (with pinafore). Students who are performing dance items may wear their dance costumes. Students who have special costumes related to the performance item (e.g. Frozen princess costume when singing 'Let it Go') can wear it for their performance.
- vi. If the file size is too big to send as an email attachment, please upload it to google drive and send us the link via email.
