Primary 3 Raffles Experience Day, 14 November 2023

In RGPS, we aim to develop our students to be creative thinkers, lilfelong learners and value-based leaders. To achieve these intended outcomes, we want to provide additional learning paths and learning experiences for our students because we believe in maximising the potential of each RGPS girl. Our students are encouraged to become partners in their own education and develop a passion and joy for learning.

Last year, we organised **Raffles Experience Day** for our Primary 3 students in a modified format, due to the Covid-19 situation then.

This year, with the easing of the safe management measures, we are glad to organise **Raffles Experience Day** for our Primary 3 students again. The Raffles Experience is delivered through the various strands:

Strands	Programme details
Individual Assessment	A survey was conducted for students in Term 2 to identify their preferred interest areas and help them understand themselves better. Students will select interest workshops on Raffles Experience Day based on their preferred interests.
Enriched Learning	We have arranged for workshops on Raffles Experience Day to cater to deeper learning for smaller groups of students. Students sign up for workshops based on their interest areas. Participation of students and their reflections will be recorded in their Reflection Journal as this serves to help each student track and own her development in her interest areas.

We have designated **14 November**, **Tuesday** to be **Raffles Experience Day** for Primary 3 students. On that day, we have managed to enlist the expertise and kind help of volunteers through our Alumni, Parent Volunteer Group and experts from various fields to conduct 17 workshops that focus on 14 interest areas of our Primary 3 students. We are grateful for the support from our valued stakeholders.

The workshops will be conducted during curriculum time.

Registration for Raffles Experience Day

A. Online Briefing

- Please remind your daughter/ward to log in to Student Learning Space (SLS) from 19 September 2023, Tuesday to 24 September 2023, Sunday, to go through the lesson package on Primary 3 Raffles Experience Day Briefing.
- 2. Students need to go through the briefing before they register for the interest workshops.

B. Online Registration

- 1. The online registration form will be available from <u>25 September 2023, Monday 3.00p.m.</u> <u>to 29 September 2023, Friday 11.45pm</u>
- 2. Students will register for their workshops via Student Learning Space (SLS).
- 3. They should log in to their Student Learning Space (SLS) account and go to the lesson package on Raffles Experience Day Interest Workshops Registration. Note that the lesson package will only be delivered to their account at 3.00p.m. on 25 September 2023.
- 4. **Each student should only choose 1 interest workshop** based on the last interest survey.
- 5. There are limited number of places for each interest workshops. If she does not find the workshop that she wants in the drop-down list, it means that all the places for that workshop have been taken. She will need to choose another workshop.
- 6. If your daughter/ward does not register by 29 September 2023, we will allocate a workshop to her based on the vacancies available.
- 7. The **confirmed list** of participants for the respective workshops will be **released by Thursday, 12 October September 2023**, through your daughter's/ward's form teacher.
- 8. Once students have registered or been allocated a place, they will not be allowed to make changes to their workshops.

9. Please take note that some workshops might require a nominal payment of not more than \$20 for materials and instructor's fee. If students have registered for or been allocated to these workshops, the school will make arrangements for the payment to be deducted from the Edusave account or GIRO*. Students who require financial assistance can let their form teachers know. Please note that there will be no refund of payment if your daughter/ward withdraws from the workshop after submission of registration online or is absent for the workshop. She will not be allowed to attend the workshop on an alternative date if she is absent for it.

Notes on Payment:

If you have already filled in an application form to withdraw monies from your child's/ward's Edusave account to co-pay the expenses for enrichment programmes, once your consent to your child's/ward's participation in the abovementioned enrichment programme(s) is received, monies will be withdrawn from your child's/ward's Edusave account in accordance with your application. You will be notified by the school if there are insufficient funds in your child's/ward's Edusave account and payment by other means is necessary.

If your daughter/ward is not eligible for Edusave, or you have not established the GIRO standing order, please make payment upon receipt of the school bill. Bills for cash-paying students will include a SGQR, which parents may scan and pay to MOE using PayNow or NETS scheme. Parents can also make payment via AXS channels of payment, kiosks, internet or mobile and cash/cheque. The cheque to be addressed to "Raffles Girls' Primary School". Students are to drop off the cash/cheque (together with hard copy school bill) at the General office.
