4. <u>P5 Prefect Outreach - Donation in Kind for Thye Hua Kwan Nursing Home and Sunbeam Place @ Singapore Children's Society</u>

The RGPS P5 prefects have come together to initiate a donation drive for Sunbeam Place run by the Singapore Children's Society and Thye Hua Kwan Nursing Home. Information about the following two beneficiaries is included below followed by a list of items requested by them.

Sunbeam Place @ Children's Society is a residential home and a gazetted place of safety for children who have been abused or neglected, and are in need of protection, or for those whose parents are unable to provide proper care. Its residents are aged between 2 and 21.

Currently, Sunbeam Place has reached out to us and is requesting for a bulk donation of stationery they need quite urgently for the children under their care.

The Thye Hua Kwan Nursing Home in Hougang serves 285 residents at the moment and at least 114 of these are patients with dementia. The Nursing Home believes in providing quality of life for aging Singaporeans. Thye Hua Kwan endeavours to assist anyone who needs help in every way possible with full respect to their race, creed, language, culture and religion.

We hope that through this activity, pupils will be able to show empathy, gratitude for the food they have been provided and graciousness towards others, especially those who are not as healthy or well off as they are. We also hope that this will help to highlight the plight of the groups of society being helped by these two organisations. We also hope that our pupils can become more aware of some of the issues our elderly and those with dementia may face; as well as those of other less fortunate children and youths.

Our school will be commemorating Odd Socks Day! This will be in line with our school's recent initiative 'That's Not Cool' which aims to perpetuate a caring and enabling school environment. 'That's Not Cool' is an upstream effort to have a greater awareness on what are cool (e.g. kind, well-meaning or gracious) and uncool behaviours (e.g. hurtful, mean or impolite).

Odd Socks Day, on the other hand, is not only a great way to express one's uniqueness, but it is also a platform to embrace differences and be kind. Our main objective is to remind the students to think about their words before they say them and their effect on others. It is an opportunity to encourage students to express themselves and celebrate their individuality. Matching socks are usually the norm, however, on Odd Socks Day this rule no longer applies. Students can bring a combination of any sock colour or design.

To make this initiative a success, we strongly encourage the students to bring their unique socks and they will be wearing it together as a class at the start of the day.
