ABOUT THE AUTHOR AND PRESENTER

Clara Mok is an English educator and writer who enjoys reflecting on her childhood and capturing glimpses of Singapore's past before they fade. She is the author of *Flying Cart Adventures*, a bilingual picture book series supported by the Lee Kuan Yew Bilingualism Fund and published by Child Ed. A graduate of Nanyang Technological University, Clara was selected for the National Arts Council's Mentor Access Project in 2016/17. Her short stories, including "The Many Painted Faces of Chinese Opera" "Newspaper Phantom" and "The Lantern Maker's Wife", have been featured in anthologies by Marshall Cavendish and Penguin SEA. Clara continues to inspire young writers by sharing her passion for storytelling in the classroom.
