### **Workshop Details**

Focus: Sustainability (Eco-Stewardship Collaboration)

Title: Personal Eco Habits of an 8-year-old

Cost: \$20 (Materials/Instructor's Fee)

Synopsis:

This workshop empowers students as Eco Stewards, exploring the impact of food choices on environmental sustainability. Aligned with the Singapore Green Plan 2030's "30-by-30" food security target, students will examine food systems and cultivate sustainable habits. Through interactive activities, they will tackle a food-related eco-challenge, focusing on food waste. Students will learn to be aware of food waste's impact, be accountable for their food choices, and apply solutions to promote food security and prevent waste.

**Important Notes:**

- Workshop fees will not exceed \$35 for materials and instructor's fees
- Payment will be deducted from the Edusave account or through GIRO
- Students requiring financial assistance should inform their form teachers
- No refunds will be provided for absent students

**Notes on Payment:**

*If you have already filled in an application form to withdraw monies from your child's/ward's Edusave account to co-pay the expenses for enrichment programmes, once your consent to your child's/ward's participation in the above-mentioned enrichment programme(s) is received, monies will be withdrawn from your child's/ward's Edusave account in accordance with your application. You will be notified by the school if there are insufficient funds in your child's/ward's Edusave account and payment by other means is necessary.*

*If your daughter/ward is not eligible for Edusave, or you have not established the GIRO standing order, please make payment upon receipt of the school bill. Bills for cash-paying students will include a SGQR, which parents may scan and pay to MOE using PayNow or NETS scheme. Parents can also make payment via AXS channels of payment, kiosks, internet or mobile and cash/cheque. The cheque to be addressed to “Raffles Girls' Primary School”. Students are to drop off the cash/cheque (together with hard copy school bill) at the General office.*
