4. Estate Upgrading Works in Watten Estate

PUB has worked with the community partners to carry out drainage improvement works along Hillcrest Road (between Watten Rise and Dunearn Road) from 2 June 2025. The works are expected to complete by Q4 2025.

Please refer to the advisory from PUB on the scope of works and the measures taken to address the safety of our students and the residents during this period.

The existing footpath would be closed off during the drainage works and students are advised to use the alternative footpath shown in the advisory.

Hillcrest Road (from Dunearn Road to Watten Rise) will be reduced to one lane during 9.30am to 4.30pm. Please follow the instructions of the traffic controllers deployed along Hillcrest Road to guide the traffic along the work areas.

RGPS will work closely with PUB to minimise inconvenience and address safety concerns during the period of estate upgrading.

5. Traffic Advisory

Please do not park your cars indiscriminately along Hillcrest Road and Watten Rise during school dismissal. Indiscriminate parking makes traffic impassable and has resulted in a few near misses. LTA deploys officers to carry out ground enforcement of traffic rules and will issue summons to drivers who infringe the rules. Please refer to the attached advisory notice from LTA for more information. Please refer to the section on Estate Upgrading Works for additional traffic advice.

6. Safe Management Measures

Students are to bring their digital thermometers on 9 July (Wed) for Temperature Taking Exercise. Please ensure that the thermometer works.

In line with MOH's advice and as part of our efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of our students and staff, please observe the following measures:

- If your child/ward is feeling unwell, please take her to see a doctor and let her rest at home.
- If your child/ward is recovering from respiratory-related illnesses, she is to wear a mask and minimise social interactions with big groups.
- Maintain good personal hygiene and improve hand hygiene by using sanitizers and soap available in school.

Your vigilance and cooperation are important in keeping our school safe for all.

There will be no make-up for weighted assessments and end-of-year examination. Students who are absent on the day of assessment are to submit valid supporting documents (e.g. medical certificate) to their form teachers upon returning to school the next day. Student's performance for that subject would be captured as 'VR' (Valid Reason). The overall marks for that subject would then be pro-rated accordingly.

For cases of absence without a valid or approved reason supported by the school (e.g. external performances or competitions), results will be reflected as 'AB' (Absent). This would mean that the student would not be awarded any marks for the assessment and/or paper missed.

Do continue to support your child/ward in her learning and encourage her to find joy in her educational journey.
