4. Estate Upgrading Works in Watten Estate

PUB has worked with the community partners to carry out drainage improvement works along Hillcrest Road (between Watten Rise and Dunearn Road) from 2 June 2025. The works are expected to complete by Q4 2025.

Please refer to the advisory from PUB on the scope of works and the measures taken to address the safety of our students and the residents during this period.

The existing footpath would be closed off during the drainage works and students are advised to us the alternative footpath shown in the advisory.

Hillcrest Road (from Dunearn Road to Watten Rise) will be reduced to one lane during 9.30am to 4.30pm. Please follow the instructions of the traffic controllers deployed along Hillcrest Road to guide the traffic along the work areas.

RGPS will work closely with PUB to minimise inconvenience and address safety concerns during the period of estate upgrading.

5. Traffic Advisory

Please do not park your cars indiscriminately along Hillcrest Road and Watten Rise during school dismissal. Indiscriminate parking makes traffic impassable and has resulted in a few near misses. LTA deploys officers to carry out ground enforcement of traffic rules and will issue summons to drivers who infringe the rules. Please refer to the attached advisory notice from LTA for more information. Please refer to the section on Estate Upgrading Works for additional traffic advice.

6. Safe Management Measures

Students are to bring their digital thermometers on 9 July (Wed) for Temperature Taking Exercise. Please ensure that the thermometer works.

In line with MOH's advice and as part of our efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of our students and staff, please observe the following measures:

- If your child/ward is feeling unwell, please take her to see a doctor and let her rest at home.
- If your child/ward is recovering from respiratory-related illnesses, she is to wear a mask and minimise social interactions with big groups.
- Maintain good personal hygiene and improve hand hygiene by using sanitizers and soap available in school.

Your vigilance and cooperation are important in keeping our school safe for all.

There will be no make-up for weighted assessments and end-of-year examination. Students who are absent on the day of assessment are to submit valid supporting documents (e.g. medical certificate) to their form teachers upon returning to school the next day. Student's performance for that subject would be captured as 'VR' (Valid Reason). The overall marks for that subject would then be pro-rated accordingly.

For cases of absence without a valid or approved reason supported by the school (e.g. external performances or competitions), results will be reflected as 'AB' (Absent). This would mean that the student would not be awarded any marks for the assessment and/or paper missed.

Do continue to support your child/ward in her learning and encourage her to find joy in her educational journey.

9. P5 National Education (NE) Show 2025 - "Majulah Singapura"

- a. Since 1997, the National Education (NE) Show has been organised to instill a sense of pride and belonging in our students and to bring across the significance of our National Day. Every year, the National Day Parade (NDP) full dress rehearsal provides an opportunity for the organiser to inculcate NE values into our students.
- b. This year, Singapore celebrates her 60th birthday. The theme for NDP 2025 is "Majulah Singapura" which embodies our nation's enduring spirit and aspirations. As we commemorate 60 years of independence, it calls on Singaporeans to reflect on our collective achievements while inspiring us to face future challenges and uncertainties with optimism and resilience. Drawing from our National Anthem, the theme also emphasises the values of trust, inclusivity, and mutual support, encouraging every citizen to play their part in Singapore's continued growth and success.
- c. The NDP 2025 organisers have assigned our students to attend the NE Show at the Padang on Saturday, 19 July 2025. Students are to assemble in the school hall by 2.45pm, in their P5 Camp T-shirt, school pinafore and school shoes. Please ensure that your child/ward has taken her lunch before she reports to school. Students are advised to bring only a small bag with packed food, water bottle, student pass, a recycled plastic bag to be used to contain the bento meal set, as well as to be used as a trash bag, cap, etc. (please find attached a suggested packing list). The estimated time of arrival at school after the NE Show is from 10.00pm onwards.
- d. Please pack snacks which are easy for consumption for your child/ward to bring along to the Padang. **Do not** pack food which is soup-based. The school will provide a bento meal set and a can of water (300ml) for the girls at the Padang. Please pack separate

food for your child/ward if she has any dietary restrictions. After eating, she will throw the empty bento box into her plastic bag.

- e. Various measures are put in place to facilitate the arrival and departure of schools during the show. This includes the management of a centralised bus transport "taxi" system for schools travelling by bus, the deployment of traffic marshals and selective road closures for ensuring a smoother flow of traffic. Hence, to ensure the speedy dispersal of students after the show, parents/guardian will not be allowed to pick up their child/ward from the Padang.
- f. Students will be advised to give their parents/guardian a call once they have boarded the bus to return to school if they have a handphone with them. Alternatively, parents/guardian can contact the school at **6468 4377 / 9721 0694** on the night of the NE Show for any further updates.

Please advise your child/ward that students may bring their handphone for the following purposes only:

- i. Contact parents/guardian to let them know the time of arrival at school after the NE show.
- ii. Take photographs to capture memories of the event.
- iii. They are strictly not allowed to be distracted by their phones during the show/use their handphones to chat/go on any social media platforms/play games.
- iv. Students are also not allowed to post photos of one another on social media platforms during or after the NE show.
- v. Students are responsible for the safekeeping of their phones. The school will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- g. To ensure a smooth traffic flow along Hillcrest Road for the returning buses to turn into RGPS on time, we seek your co-operation not to arrive in school until you have received a call from your child/ward of her estimated time of arrival in school.
- h. The dismissal point on the night of Saturday, 19 July, will be at the **canteen pickup point.** For safety reasons, students will not be allowed to wait along Hillcrest Road. Parents/Guardian who park around the school vicinity will have to enter the school to pick up their child/ward at the canteen pick-up point area.
- i. To prevent traffic congestion and crowding outside the school gate, LTA will continue the arrangement of not allowing any vehicles to wait along Dunearn Road and Hillcrest Road ahead of time before the school gate is open. LTA will take enforcement action against vehicles found waiting/parking before the school gate opens.
- j. The estimated dismissal time from the Padang is 8.20pm 9.00pm. The school gate will only be opened for parents/guardian to pick up their child/ward after all the buses have left the school.
- k. We strongly encourage you to arrive at an appropriate time and should you arrive early, please wait at any nearby parking facilities before making your way down to pick up your child/ward.
- I. Please note that <u>ALL</u> students will have to be fetched by a parent/guardian from RGPS on the night of the NE Show. Kindly indicate the name of the person fetching the child and his/her contact number by clicking on the link here: https://forms.moe.edu.sq/forms/vKLdL9

- m. If your child/ward is not well on the day of the NE Show, please let her rest and not participate in this event.
- n. We strongly encourage your child/ward to attend the NE Show as it will form part of her memorable school experiences with her peers. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this notification via Parents Gateway by 11 July 2025.
- o. We sincerely seek your fullest co-operation in complying with our dismissal procedures on the night of 19 July 2025 to ensure the safety of all our students.

A briefing for your child/ward will be conducted in Term 3, Week 1, by her Form Teachers, to inform her of details pertaining to this event.
