1. School Uniform Requirements for 2026

We hope you and your families had a wonderful holiday break and are settling well into the new school year.

We would like to remind all parents about our school uniform policy for 2026. Last year, due to exceptionally hot weather conditions, students were permitted to wear PE attire to school as a temporary measure. With the start of the new academic year, we are resuming our standard uniform requirements.

As communicated to our students during Welcome Back to School (WBTS), **all students are required to wear their school pinafores daily**. The guidelines are as follows:

Days with PE lessons: Students may wear PE t-shirts underneath their pinafores for convenience, allowing them to simply remove their pinafores during physical education classes. The PE t-shirt must be tucked in when worn at all times.

Days without PE lessons: Students should wear school blouses underneath their pinafores as per our school rule.

We have observed that our girls are sporting pinafores that are too high above the knees. Please ensure pinafores reach the knees and that the belt Velcro fastens securely. Velcro strips are available at retail shops throughout Singapore. Please also refer to the uniform guidelines in the Student Handbook distributed to your daughter/ward.

We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining proper school attire, which helps preserve our school's identity and creates a conducive learning environment.

5. Addition and Alteration Works for the Installation of Air-conditioning Systems to Multi-Purpose Hall
