Important Notes for Students and Parents

1. English and Mother Tongue Oral Examination

The school will be conducting the English and Mother Tongue oral examinations which are part of the P6 Preliminary Examination. The examination dates are as follows:

Students are required to stay back in school on the above dates. As the oral examinations are held outside students' school hours, please make the necessary lunch and transport arrangements.

- P6 students who are exempted from taking MT or who are taking NTIL/Foreign Languages need not come to school on 21 and 25 August 2026.
- P6 students who are not taking HMT need not come to school on 25 August 2026.
- Students who are unwell on the day of the examination should not come to school in the interest of their physical and mental well-being. If she is already unwell and still reports to school, she will not be allowed to take part in examination and parent/guardian will be contacted to take your child/ward home to rest. Students who are **absent** from the examination need to produce a **valid Medical Certificate**. They can choose whether to sit for the make-up paper. They will take the paper on the first day when they return to school should they decide to sit for it.
- The last day of make-up exam for P6 will be on **26 August 2026**.
- The papers that students are not allowed to re-sit if they are absent are:
 - English Language Paper 1 and Listening Comprehension
 - Mother Tongue Paper 1 and Listening Comprehension
 - Higher Mother Tongue Paper 1
- In accordance with the requirement for PSLE candidates to use ballpoint pen (no correction tape) in the examination, P6 students will only be allowed to use blue/black ballpoint pen for this examination. This is to ensure clarity of the candidates' scanned responses to facilitate the PSLE online marking.
