1. RGPS Traffic Advisory- Reminder on Traffic Management Arrangement Along Dunearn Road & Hillcrest Road during School Dismissal from Land Transport Authority (LTA)

With the commencement of the new school term on 29 June 2026, the Land Transport Authority (LTA) would like to remind all parents/guardians to **refrain from waiting or parking your vehicles indiscriminately around the school vicinity before school dismissal**. Such indiscriminate parking behaviour could potentially cause inconvenience, obstruction and danger to other road users.

The school will continue the existing traffic management arrangement along Dunearn Road and Hillcrest Road to minimise traffic congestion and crowding outside the school gate. Under this arrangement, **vehicles are not permitted to wait along the highlighted roads before the school gate opens for dismissal** (refer to map in Annex A). Please also note the following:

- a. Do not park encroaching or blocking of footpaths and grass verge
- b. Do not park within 3 metres of fire hydrants, 6 metres of road junctions and 9 metres of a bus stop
- c. Do not park along roads with enforcement markings such as unbroken double yellow lines and single white zig-zag lines (zebra-controlled area)
- d. Do not park in a manner that would obstruct other vehicles from entering or exiting their residences
- e. Do not park on both sides of the road, as this will make the road impassable

LTA will take enforcement action against vehicles found committing parking offences along the affected roads. **We strongly encourage parents and guardians to arrive on time**. Should you arrive early, please wait at the nearby parking facilities before proceeding to pick up your child. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

2. Teachers' Day Celebration 2026

We will be celebrating Teachers' Day on Thursday, 3 September 2026. School hours are from 7.30 am to 10.30 am. Please make the necessary transport arrangements to pick up your child/ward. The staggered dismissal timing at Gate 1 is as follows:

- P1 – 10.20 am
- P2 & P3 – 10.25 am
- P4, P5, P6 – 10.30 am

Private vehicles will be allowed to be driven into the school at 10.40 am, after the school buses leave.

In conjunction with our RGPS R U OK? Programme and to celebrate Mental Wellness Day, students are to come to school in their school uniform and are encouraged to put on something yellow such as a yellow hairclip, yellow hairband, yellow hair tie or yellow socks (no headgear allowed).

There will be no lessons conducted on that day. Students may wish to bring decoration materials to decorate the class whiteboard for the classroom activities. As the canteen will not be open, please pack food/snacks for your child/ward.

We would like to advise your child/ward not to buy gifts for her teachers. A simple card or something that she has made will suffice in showing appreciation to her teachers.

Our former students are allowed to come back to school to visit the teachers. They can visit their teachers from 11.00 am to 12.30 pm.

Students will not attend school on 4 September due to Teachers' Day holiday. This is followed by the September holidays from 5 to 13 September. Students will return to school on 14 September.

3. Temporary Arrangement: PE Attire for School Days

As many of you are aware, we have been experiencing particularly hot and humid weather conditions recently. The comfort and well-being of our students is always at the heart of every decision we make, and we have been listening closely to the concerns raised by both our students and parents regarding the current weather.

We are pleased to share that, in light of these conditions, **students will be allowed to report to school in their PE attire** with immediate effect. We believe this small adjustment will go a long way in helping our girls stay cool, comfortable, and ready to learn each day.

Girls who prefer to continue wearing their **pinafores** are also welcome to do so — the choice is entirely up to each student and her comfort.

Please note that this is a **temporary arrangement**. Once the weather becomes more comfortable, students will be required to return to reporting in their regular school uniform. We will keep you informed of this transition well in advance.

We are truly grateful for your understanding and for the open communication between our school community. It is because of your voices — and those of our wonderful students — that we are able to make thoughtful decisions that put their well-being first.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support and partnership. Together, we will continue to create a warm, caring, and nurturing environment for every child at RGPS.

4. Use of the Air-Conditioned Hall for the Preliminary Examination Written Papers

We would like to inform you that the written papers for the Preliminary Examination (19 to 25 August) will be conducted in our newly air-conditioned school hall. This provides a cooler and more comfortable environment for students during their examination, particularly during periods of warm and humid weather.

As individual comfort levels vary, some students may find the hall cool during the examination. You may wish to have your child/ward bring a light sweater or jacket so that she remains comfortable during the examination. The temperature in the hall will be monitored throughout the examination to provide a conducive environment for students.

5. Pre-PSLE Study Break for the P6 Cohort (21–23 September 2026)

With reference to the 2026 Term 4 Calendar of Events disseminated at the start of Semester 2, the school will be implementing a three-day study break for P6 students from 21 to 23 September (Monday to Wednesday).

During this period, P6 subject teachers will be conducting consultation sessions via Teams. Students are to follow their individual class timetable. Details of the Teams sessions will be

shared by your child's/ward's respective subject teachers via SLS by Term 4 Week 1. It is not compulsory for your child/ward to join the Teams consultation sessions.

6. Primary 6 September Holiday Consultation Sessions via Teams (10 September 2026)

Please be informed that the P6 subject teachers (English, Mathematics, Science and Mother Tongue except NTIL) will be conducting consultation sessions via Microsoft Teams for Primary 6 students on 10 September, Thursday, from 8.00am to 12.30pm. These sessions provide individual or small-group academic and emotional support to Primary 6 students, helping them consolidate learning, clarify doubts and build confidence in preparation for their upcoming Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE).

To ensure your child/ward can participate in the upcoming Teams consultation sessions with her teachers, please download the Microsoft Teams app on a compatible device (phone, tablet or computer) that your child/ward can use.
