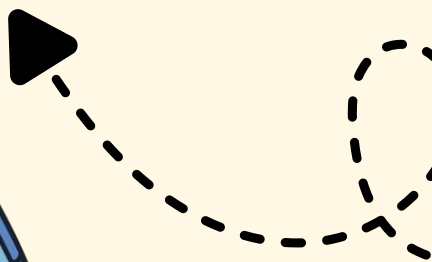
## Self-Leadership

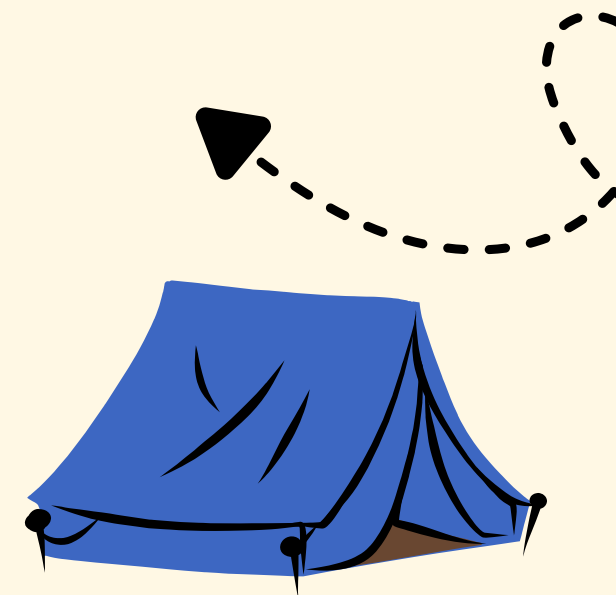
# WHY CAMPING IS GREAT FOR STUDENTS?
